

## **SSI-17: Proceedings Information and Submission of Manuscripts.**

Selected papers from the Conference will be published as a special volume of the journal Solid State Ionics. Only those papers which were actually presented, and which have successfully been through the journal's peer review process will be included in the Proceedings. It is anticipated that the Proceedings volume will be published in mid-2010.

Keynote and Contributed papers are limited to a maximum of 4 (four) printed journal pages, to allow for a manageable volume size for the proceedings.

The following is a Guide for Authors.

### Submission of papers

Authors are required to submit their manuscripts online to the Solid State Ionics web site at External link <http://ees.elsevier.com/ssi/>. Please consult first the Tutorial for Authors before beginning the submission procedure.

Deadline for Initial Manuscript: September 1, 2009

*Type of submission.* SSI-17 authors must use the appropriate item in the pull-down menu regarding type of submission. That is, the **SSI-17 Special Issue**, and not *Regular Article*.

The Ethical Statement is mandatory for research articles, as well as for special issues submitted to Solid State Ionics -Diffusion and Reactions: 1) the material has not been published in whole or in part elsewhere; 2) the paper is not currently being considered for publication elsewhere; 3) all authors have been personally and actively involved in substantive work leading to the paper, and will hold themselves jointly and individually responsible for its content.

For review purposes a platform-independent PDF manuscript file with embedded figures is preferred. The authors can either upload PDF files or have them built from source files in the online submission process. Please be sure to carefully check the built PDF file before final submission, since math and special characters may not have converted properly. After acceptance, the authors are invited to provide electronic source files of text (MS-Word, Latex, etc.) and figures (EPS, TIFF, JPEG, etc.), if they are not already available, for the publication process.

### Manuscript preparation

All manuscripts should be written in clear and grammatically correct English and properly formatted. Manuscripts may be prepared using MS-Word or LaTeX. The Elsevier LaTeX package can be obtained at External link <http://www.elsevier.com/latex>. Structure. Double spaced; single (wide) column; font size 10 or larger; and in the following order: Article Title, Author(s), Affiliation(s), Abstract and Keywords located

on the title page; followed by the Main text with numbered Sections (1. Introduction, 2. Experimental, etc.), Acknowledgements, Appendices, List of References, Tables, Figure Caption list and Table Caption list. The Figures should be included on separate pages at the end of the manuscript. All pages should be numbered.

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### After acceptance

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
